The Foundation of Fulton Montgomery Community College has announced today that The Delaney Family Foundation has donated \$ 100,000.00 to help fund the college's new Athletic Turf Field on campus. Phase 1 of these fields has introduced a Soccer turf field which will be named "Delaney Field". FMCC will partner with local high schools, youth organization and other interested clubs and vendors to host events, trainings and camps. Upgrading our athletic facilities will enhance college enrollment in an enduring and sustainable way.

Fulton-Montgomery Community College has a long and rich history of athletic competition. FM offers intercollegiate athletic opportunities for male and female athletes in the fall, winter, and spring seasons.

FM is a Division III member of the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA). The Raiders compete in the Mountain Valley Conference, which consists of nine junior colleges located in eastern New York. The eight other conference members are Adirondack, Clinton, Columbia-Greene, Herkimer, Hudson Valley, Mohawk Valley, North Country and Schenectady.

The Mountain Valley Conference and two other conferences (one in the middle and another in the western part of New York State) make up the NJCAA's Region 3.

The athletic program has thrived since FM was founded in 1963. The Raiders have won 34 Mountain Valley Conference championships (most recently the 2023-24 women's volleyball and women's basketball) and eleven Region 3 championships
